The PADI Advanced Open Water Diver program requires a total of 5 training dives. Two dives are required, Deep and Navigation. The other 3 are elective dives chosen by the student. It will usually take 2 weekends of diving to complete all training requirements. We recommend doing the navigation dive at an inland dive site such as the Florida Springs or a Quarry. We also recommend that you make a trip to the Gulf of Mexico as well. A trip to the Gulf will expose you to boat diving procedures and introduce you to diving in a salt water environment. Not to mention that it's FUN!!
